Julia Cameron long ago grew tired of the men her father keeps dropping on her doorstep. They are all as cold, frigid, and robotic as her father himself. Samuel Adam is just one more in a string of men that she is determined to blow off. All she has to do is survive this plane trip back home with him, and he can go his cold and tyrannical way – alone.

Surviving the trip becomes harder than she could have imagined when their plane makes a crash landing into the ocean. Set adrift with Samuel, she has nothing but time – time to think about her disastrous love history, and what she really wants in a soul mate - passion, a complete meeting of the mind and soul. Julia will accept nothing less. But as she comes to depend on Samuel for her survival, she learns there is more to the man than she saw at first glance. As they explore first the island, then each other, they find they have something in common after all – a passion that sweeps them into its fire. Samuel's domination strikes a note with Julia she had never thought to find, and she revels in submitting to his demands and desires.

Jaid Black creates strong characters who can be strong and still submissive, and writes believably arousing scenes of dominance. The sex is intense and explicit, but balanced by a strong plot and witty dialogue. *Adam and Evil* is an erotic delight from start to end.
